

The regular monthly meeting of the French Creek Town board was held on Monday July 11, 2022. Those present were; Board members Norvel Willink, Paul Carey, Wayne Emory and Brynne Hinsdale. Supervisor David White, Town Clerk Debbra Albright and Highway supervisor Brian Malecki.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm.

The minutes were then read, David White motioned to approve, it was seconded by Mr. Willink and followed with 5 ayes.

There was no assessors report. The justice report included a letter from the Justice that stated that all tickets issued in May and June have to be dismissed. All tickets issued in Sherman Mina and Clymer said they took place in Mina Township so for jurisdiction purposes all the Clymer and Sherman tickets had to be dismissed. That has now been corrected so it doesn't happen again.

Public comment was then opened. There was one resident present and he asked why the minutes hadn't been posted online since April. Dave told him he was responsible and just hadn't had time. He told him he would address that.

There was a short discussion on the salt shed. Things are currently at a standstill until the financing gets finalized. Mr. White is doing that part and Brian has the grant part set. The building has been ordered and has wait time.

Mr. White got word that we would be receiving the second half of the American Rescue fund which should be around \$43,743.00.

The State hazard mitigation team is requesting a zoom meeting to update a hazard mitigation plan. The last one was in 2016. Mr. White will be checking into it and letting us know what we will have to do for that.

A resolution was presented for establishing the price of a building permit for the solar project. It was agreed to charge the rate of \$2000.00 per megawatt. It was approved and signed by all board members.

Brian Malecki gave his report on the paving and machinery repairs. All paving is done for now because the funds for that are done.

The bills were presented for payment. Mr. White made the motion to approve, it was seconded by Mr. Carey, third by Mr. Willink, followed by 5 ayes.

Mr. White then moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:33pm. It was seconded by Mr. Emory and third by Mr. Carey, followed by 5 ayes.
