

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of French Creek Town board was held on June 13, 2022 at the town highway building.

Those present were Paul Carey, Norvel Willink, and Wayne Emory, board members. Brian Malecki , Highway supervisor, David White, Town supervisor, Debbra Albright, Town clerk and Jeff Messinger, code officer.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm. The minutes were read and approved. Motioned to approve by Mr. White. Seconded by Mr. Willink followed by Mr. Carey, followed by 4 ayes.

Mr. Messinger then gave the code report and progress of others already approved. Mrs. Hindsdale joined the meeting at 7:39pm. Mr. White then gave the assessors report. There was no justice report.

Mr. White passed out a paper from the state with decommissioning concerns that were addressed on the solar project. All members agreed that there are no other concerns at this time and they will go forward in the process of issuing a special use permit to Omni French Creek LLC. A resolution was passed and approved.

Mr. Malecki gave a report on the progress of the salt shed. A compromise was made on the size in order to stay in the price range they needed. Mr. White made the motion to go ahead with the purchase. It was moved by Mr. Carey, seconded by Mr. Emory followed by 5 ayes.

Mr. White notified the board that health insurance would be increasing by 9.6% this coming year.

The town supervisor signed an agreement with the shared dog catcher, Kelly Thornton so she can house stray dogs. She will also need to sign an Office of Oath with the Town Clerk so she can issue tickets to people in violation of dog laws.

The Town Clerk presented a proposal for a software program to be installed and maintained by Williamson Law book Company. Moved to approve by Mr. Willink and seconded by Mr. Carey, followed by 5 ayes.

Mr. Malecki expressed his concerns with finding a new employee to replace Scott Reynolds when he retires. The ad that was placed in the Post Journal didn't yield any prospects. The Town clerk will post to face book and check into putting it in the Corry Journal.

The bills were presented for payment in the amount of \$49,233.57 for the Highway fund and \$2558.42 for the General fund. Mr. White motioned to approve, seconded by Mrs. Hindsdale and 3rd by Mr. Carey.

The motion was made to adjourn by Mr. White at 9:17pm, 2nd by Mr. Willink and 3rd by Mr. Carey.
